A SERIES SJOSEPH

- God loves everyone the same.

Discipleship Strategy 2023-24

We believe that church is a community and that discipleship happens when people engage in 1) honest biblical teaching while 2) surrounded by people who know them deeply and 3) are regularly practicing habits of a Jesus life-style. We believe that the Holy Spirit works through these habits to deeply transform lives. That means that faith formation doesn't just happen at church on Sunday mornings, it happens all the time!

Growing with our peers.

Every stage of childhood development brings unique experiences to the family. Whether it's carrying around a diaper bag, or learning to potty train, starting school, or entering puberty, all of these milestones change the dynamic of the whole family. This is why we want our kids to grow in peer communities. Age groups are put together not only for the children to meet others who are experiencing the world in similar ways, but it also allows parents of similar stages to interact with each other through serving on the team, or at drop offs and pick ups.

Habits and rhythms of following Jesus are best taught through the example of mature Christians. Our programs are full of disciplemaking volunteers of all generations whose lives testify to the transformative work of the Holy Spirit. Our team is made of loving volunteers who are invested in the growth of the next generation of Jesus followers, and it's by their example that our students will learn what it looks like to follow Jesus as a teenager, as a young adult, an adult, and a senior.

Exploring the big picture of scripture.

Scripture is one story that reveals Jesus Christ as the saviour of the world. We follow the church liturgical calendar every year so that students can participate in every aspect of scripture starting with the old testament prophets, the life and ministry of Jesus, and the new church communities that unfolded after Christ's resurrection. It's really important that children attend consistently through the year so they can experience God's Story from start to finish.

Multi-generational care and support.

Children need committed parents and guardians to help their faith flourish. That means that it will take intention, time and sometimes courage to remain in church community even when it's easier not to.
